Keeping the organization alive & vibrant requires a lot of behind the scenes work including everything from serving on committees to helping to sell raffle tickets, or books from our library, to bringing friends to the meetings, to helping to arrange & hang shows, to helping to finding additional AOTM locations ... there are, literally, dozens of ways to volunteer! So nominate the person who you see as being a valuable asset to MAA. Also remember that your nomination will need to be more than just a name, but will need a paragraph or two on WHY you think that person should be Artist of The Year. **Ballots will be in the May Newsletter & voting will take place at the May Meeting. Winner to be announced and awarded at our June gathering.**
